Scholarship Qualifications & Criteria - Applicants must be able to prove:

- They are actively majoring in, taking classes, or engaged in independent studies in one or more of the qualifying media fields for the Fall /Spring terms of 2026/2027.
- They are in good standing with their academic institution. Entry rules: Entrants must submit an essay under 500 words describing their creative coursework, portfolio or project and how it relates to this scholarship award. Supplemental links to media projects are welcome. Winners will be selected based on their overall academic performance, portfolio and their personal statement.
